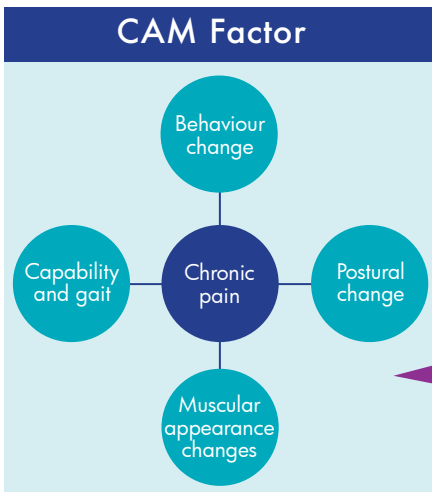


# Arthritic Pets

The diagram below shows the different ways osteoarthritis can affect our pets, they can show all, some or just one of these signs which can include:

- Unusual or different behaviour
- Pacing at night
- Licking their joints
- Being unwilling to go for a walk
- Weak hind legs
- Limping and lameness
- Changes in how they stand or sit
- Depression or low mood
- Sleeping more than usual
- Temperament changes
- Difficulty getting comfortable
- Difficulty going to the toilet
- Difficulty using litter tray
- Physical and muscular changes.

A lot of these signs can be subtle and intermittent, if you think that your pet might be affected, please phone to make an appointment with your vet.
